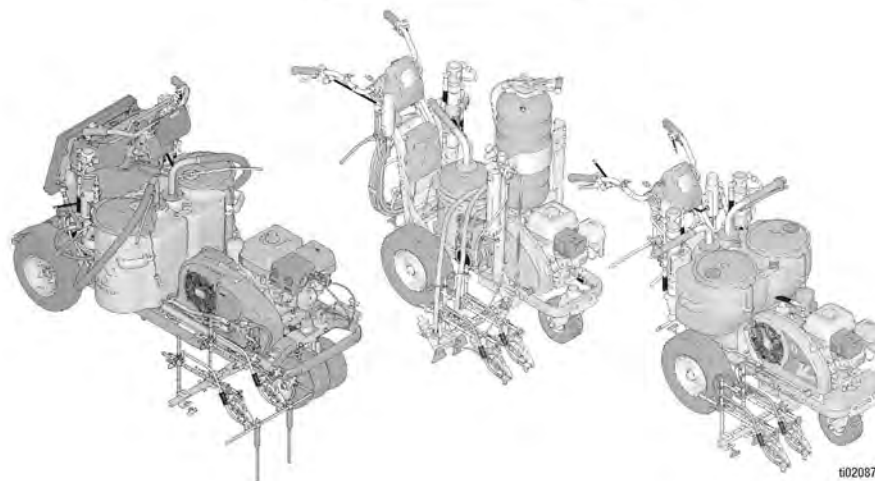
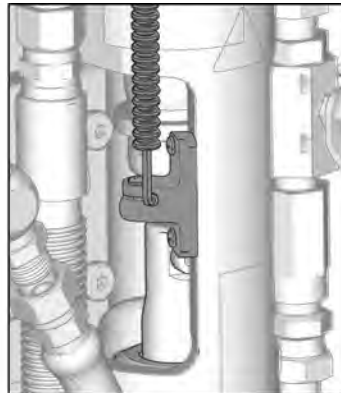

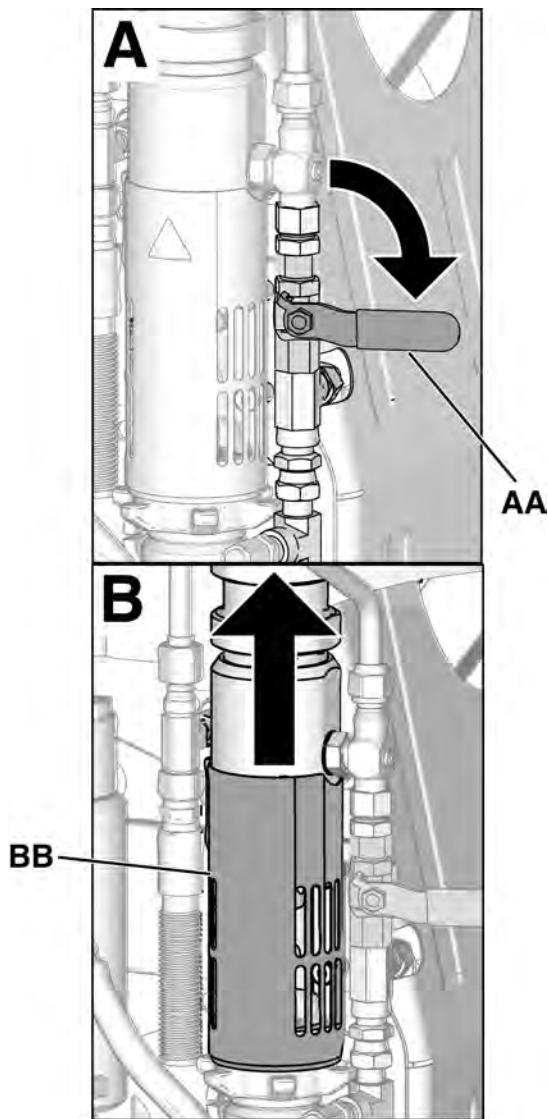

Removing Existing Gallon Counter



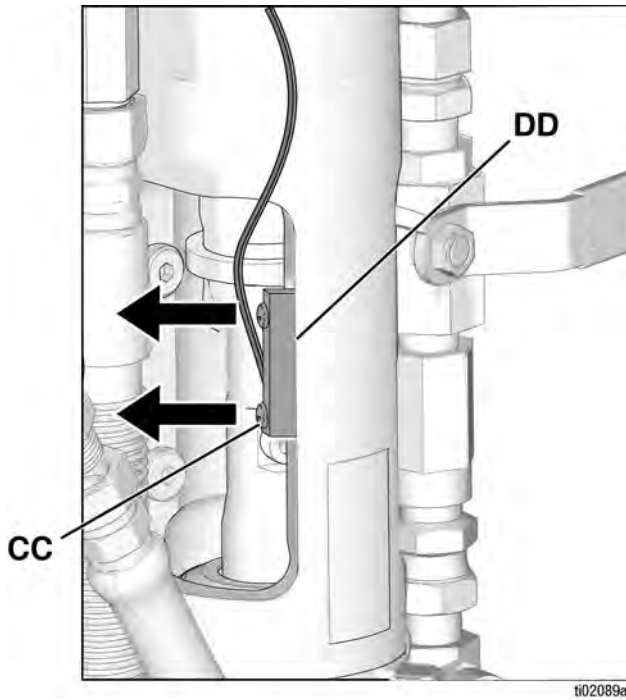
This equipment stays pressurized until pressure is manually relieved. To help prevent serious injury from moving parts, follow the Pressure Relief Procedure when you stop spraying and before cleaning, checking, or servicing the equipment.

1. Allow the sprayer to cool.
2. Follow the **Pressure Relief Procedure** in your LineLazer manual.
3. Turn unit OFF.
4. Close hydraulic valve (AA).
5. Remove shield (BB).



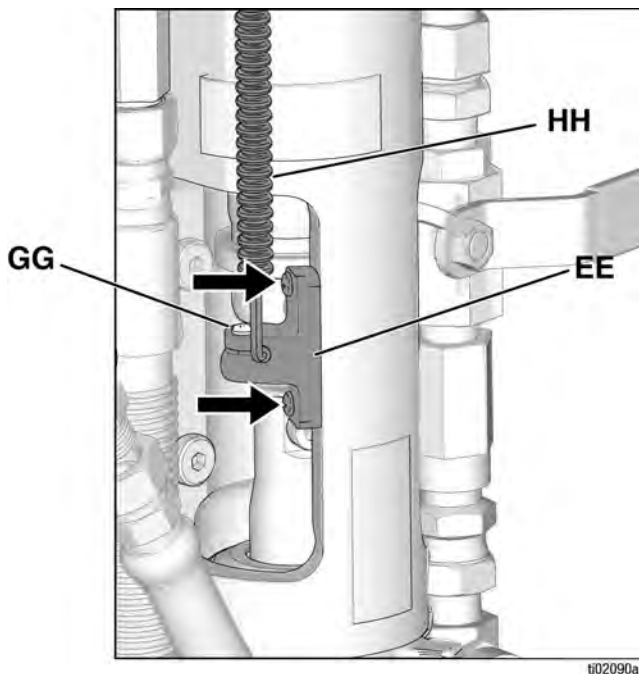
Removing Existing Gallon Counter

- Remove two screws (CC) securing existing gallon counter (DD). Remove gallon counter.

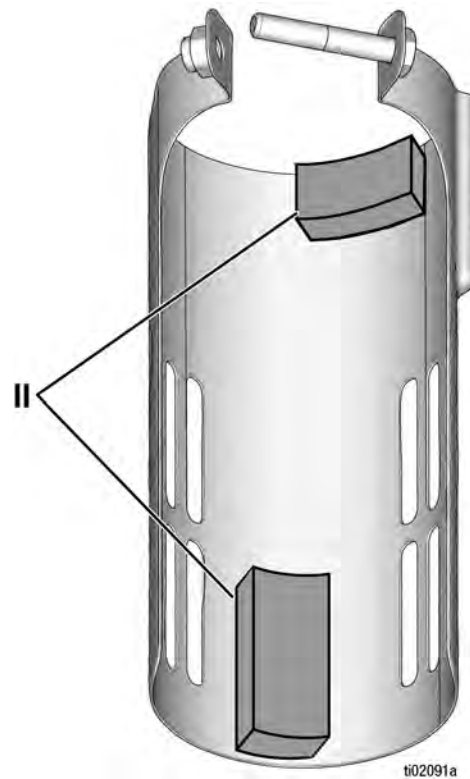


- Install two screws to secure gallon counter bracket (EE) to pump housing. Ensure screw (GG) is facing upwards.

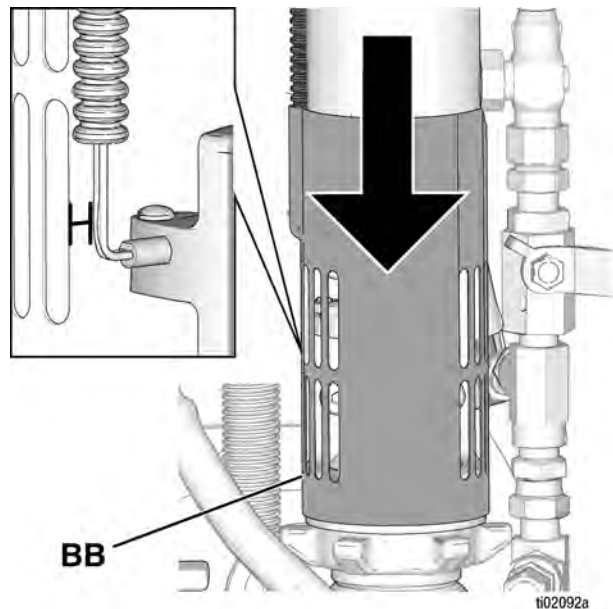
- Route new wiring (HH) along path of old wiring. Disconnect existing gallon counter connector and connect replacement gallon counter.



- Cut foam (II) into two equal pieces. Remove backing and adhere in approximate locations shown.



- Reinstall shield (BB). Ensure clearance between gallon counter wires and shield.
